



Student Drink Policy All Vessels

Due to recent problems experienced with intoxication amongst our passengers to dangerous levels on board the Dutch Master, we have had to enforce the below bar rules on all events board the Dutch Master;

- We are unable to sell wine by the bottle. Guests can buy a bottle of Wine however this will need to be poured into glasses upon service.
- We are unable to sell shots of spirits, we will sell spirits with mixers in no more than single measures and no more than one at a time.
- We will not serve intoxicated passengers and we reserve the right to close our bars if we feel that there are too many intoxicated passengers on board.
- There is a minimum bar spend of £10 or a minimum of two draft products.

Our security team will be in place to enforce such measures and we will remind customers that security will also confiscate drugs or any other illegal substances found to be in the possession of our passengers. Both ourselves as the vessel owners and yourself as event organisers have a duty of care to the passengers, and in line with our terms and conditions, we reserve the right to refuse admission to passengers whose behaviour might in our judgement compromise the safety of themselves, or that of other passengers and the vessel. We also reserve the right to disembark passengers for the same reason once the cruise has commenced.

Finally we reserve the right to terminate any cruise where we believe the behaviour of passengers compromises the safety of the other passengers and the vessel.
